## P.A.L. Opioid, Concussion, and Sudden Cardiac Arrest Fact Sheet Acknowledgment

Many of our schools may include this with the student's registration, but just in case, it is the law that you have this for any student who participates in the PAL, including Little Dribbler and it must be done once a year.

Parents and their student athlete must sign the Opioid, Concussion, and Sudden Cardiac Arrest Fact Sheet Acknowledgement Form **yearly**. These acknowledgement form(s) are kept at the school site and monitored by the school principal and or the Athletic Director. California law requires each athlete (and his or her parent for those 17 and younger) participating in an athletic program that takes place outside of the regular school day **sign** an acknowledgment of receipt that the athlete and his or her parent have received an Opioid, Concussion, and Sudden Cardiac Arrest Fact Sheet before the athlete may participate in practices or competition.
