

Fourth Grade School Supplies

(These supplies are separate from your Art and Spanish supplies. I will be emailing this to all so you can use the links. If you click on the link it will show you an example. **Do not feel obligated** to order from Amazon it is just for reference). **Please fill out divider tabs-See Below.**

- [Backpack](#) - big enough to accommodate binder + 2 text books (When standing it must be under 19 $\frac{3}{4}$ " tall to fit under cubbies, rolling is ok but not mandatory)
- [1 binder](#) (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches 3 ring). "Trapper Keeper" style binders are too big(please don't buy).
- 1 package of [dividers](#) with tabs (Students will need 8 dividers Math, Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, Writers Workshop, Spelling, Vocabulary, Spanish). If you have an extra you can put a paper divider in the back of the binder for a few binder and graph paper. Please fill out tabs and place them in the binder in the order above.
- 1 [glue sticks](#) + 1 small bottle [Elmer's Glue](#)
- 1 pair of small [scissors](#) put the student's name on them (use a sharpie).
- 1 **clear (non-color)** [ruler](#) with inches and centimeters. Put students' names on it (towards one end) with a narrow permanent marker. It is important to not write on any numbers or hash marks. I like the Staples [ruler](#). Please **do not** get a bendy/flexible ruler.
- 2 boxes (24-30) of SHARPENED number 2 [pencils](#).
- 1 box [red pens](#) (**no retractable** or erasable pens, please)
- 1 dry [erase board](#) (approx. 9x12 no stands or frames attached to it. **The surface is blank**, no lines.) 3-4 dry [erase markers](#) (chisel tip, black, blue, red or green + [eraser](#) (old sock will also work)
- 2 [highlighter pens](#), small tip, **yellow only**
- 1 [pencil box](#) to hold pencils, red pens, highlighter, dry erase markers in your desk (write students name on bottom in permanent maker).
- [Colored pencils](#) (24 is a good variety), [crayons](#) and 1 package thin tipped colored markers (to be kept in cubby). Larger sets are ok.
- 4 [Jumbo Book Sox](#) or other book covers (4 different **solid** covers, no patterns).
- 4 Packages [wide ruled binder paper](#)(200) (for classroom) + start with some in your binder

- 2 Pads of [Graph paper](#)
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
- 1 [personal hand sanitizer](#) for desk and 1 for the classroom (8oz or larger)
- 1 [Project cover](#) (can be used) for Mission Report. **Put their name on the inside.**
- 1 [Binder \(\$\frac{1}{2}\$ "](#)) for Historical Site Summer extra credit and field trips - cardstock blank pages to fit binder + scrapbooking supplies such as fancy paper, stickers, fun scissors, etc are optional. You will keep at home to complete extra credit. It is optional but recommended.
- [Surface Wipes](#) (soft container, please avoid the hard plastic dispenser)
- Headphones- Durable, student's name is securely attached to or written on the headphones. The headphones must have a 3.5 mm standard connector as nothing else will work.

All supplies should be brought to school on the 1st day.

PARENTS: If you don't have please purchase an [accordion folder](#) or hanging file folder crate to keep your student's returned work (**This is paramount**) - being able to label each subject works best to save work to study from for upcoming tests as well as for referencing a score. We'll discuss this more at Back-to-School Night.

Optional items the students like:

- If you have a student with allergies you may want to get them some travel size [Kleenex](#) to keep in their desk.
- [Erasers](#) large and [pencil top erasers](#)
- Mechanical pencils (some students prefer mechanical pencils and it is a personal choice).
